Acts 17

They were accused of sedition (17:7) and had to leave the city

Acts 17:6 - these men
Jonah 3:4 40 days turned the
world "upside down"
and Nineveh will be turned
"upside down"
Prayer: "upside down"

1 Th. [they thought it worthwhile to turn away from
idolatry to accept the Living God] And Paul & his companions showed Thanksgiving
them (as Christ showed his followers) that Christian leadership is
accomplished through humble service.] 2:1-12

(ch 2) Not only the leaders, but all members, are following the example
of Jesus → Jewish Christians are persecuted by the Jews
with the same attitudes of those who killed Jesus, and the
Thess. are persecuted by their fellow Greeks. → similar reasons,
although the persecutors are different

Ch 3 Paul was worried, sent Timotheus to strengthen them in their
afflictions → so happy to find out they were faithful & true.
3:4 Paul refers to a teaching he gave them in person that tribulation
would come

Ch 4 challenge to holiness
3-5 sexual purity
6-8 honesty
9-11 brotherly love
12-18 hope

the dead will join the faithful living at the second coming
of Jesus

4:15, 17 - we which are alive & remain

Ch 5 16 → image of triumphant king (Caesar) returning to city & delegation sent to meet him
BUT used to describe Christ instead

1-8 the time is unknown, but we can watch & prepare

the comparison with those who follow Caesar was made in 4:16, but now it is
contrasted — you won't feel be lulled by false (worldly) security, but will depend on God

2 Thess.

Ch 1

At the second coming...

Your persecutions will be rewarded with rest (v. 7)

and to admire God & glorify him (v. 10)

those who trouble you will be rewarded with tribulations (v. 6) and vengeance (v. 8)
and to be cast away from God's presence (v. 9)

HOPE about
persecution

Prayer: (v. 11-12)

God will count you worthy
keep his covenants to you
reward your works of faith

Jesus will be glorified in you and you in him.

Ch 2

Isaiah 13-14 Daniel 7-12 The Second coming hasn't happened yet... You didn't miss it (thief in the night)

first

- falling away

mystery of iniquity (v. 7)

- men of sin be revealed

he who "leaveth" will "let"

clarity over rapture

So be faithful and remain vigilant

- son of perdition
- makes himself God - sits in the "temple" of God
- his coming is after the working of Satan with power, signs, and lying wonders
- deceive the unrighteous

- the Lord will consume with the spirit of his mouth and the brightness of his coming

Prayer:

God - who has loved us and counted us with grace

comfort your hearts - strengthen you in your righteous words & deeds

Ch 3

distance yourselves from those who walk disorderly

we showed the example - though we had the right to demand payment,
we didn't and we taught that those unwilling to work should not eat
so remove yourselves from those who are voluntarily idle

Prayer: the Lord of peace give you peace always, and be with you
